

2022-2023 Safe Return to Learning Plan

Screening: Screen for symptoms at home. Stay home when sick.

Reporting: Contact school nurse with questions or to report a positive COVID-19 test: MS/HS: 218-568-9207, Eagle View: 218-562-6105

<u>Positive COVID-19 Test</u>: A person can end isolation after 5 full days since the onset of symptoms or the positive COVID-19 test date (if asymptomatic) if:

- 1. Fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication)
- 2. Symptoms have subsided
- 3. Wear a well-fitted mask from days 6-10

For people who test positive and are asymptomatic: If a person tests positive without symptoms and then symptoms develop later, the five-day isolation period must start over. Day zero is the first day of symptom(s) onset or the date of the positive test, whichever is later. Day one of isolation is the following day.

If a person doesn't meet all three criteria listed above, they must continue to isolate themselves for up to 10 days. Please contact your child's school nurse (MS/HS: 218-568-9207, Eagle View: 218-562-6105) if you have any questions.



<u>Face Coverings</u>: Face coverings are optional. The district has a supply of surgical, KN95 and KN98 masks available.

<u>At-Home COVID-19 Testing</u>: Please contact your child's school main office for a free at-home COVID-19 test, while supplies last.
